Fue research fellow del St. Antony's College de la Universidad de Oxford, 1963-73, colaborador de la editorial Ruedo ibérico. Co-fundador y presidente (2006-07) de la Sociedad Internacional de Economía Ecológica. Editor de la revista Ecología Política desde 1991. Ha co-dirigido unas 40 tesis doctorales en economía ecológica y ecología política en el ICTA-UAB desde 1997. Profesor de la FLACSO, Quito. Premio Leontief de Economía (2017) y Premio Balzan (2020). Ha dirigido los proyectos de investigación europeos CEECEC 2008-10, EJOLT 2011-15, y EnvJustice2016-21. Co-director del Atlas de Justicia Ambiental (EJAtlas).
